This Application Must be Typed and Printed; WE WILL NOT Accept Handwritten Applications or e-mailed applications. Applications must be mailed by regular mail and stamp or hand delivered to the office. If you wait until the last minute, the chances of your application being rejected are high. Do not wait until the last minute to apply.

Requirements for High School seniors Applicants for the OFA Scholarship: (College Applicants requirements listed on the third page)

- Transcripts must state your full name, the school you attend, and include both first semester and second semester grades from senior year. Transcripts must also show the students' GPA, 3.0 and above. Remember grammar and punctuation are taken into consideration.
- Letter of acceptance from the College/University you are planning to attend.
- Letter of recommendation from any person that knows you well (Teacher, Counselor, or Coach)
- Written essay of at least 1 page (single-spaced) explaining why you qualify to receive the \$500.00 to \$1,000 OFA Scholarship. You can write about family, hobbies, friends, community service or anything that you have done to make a difference in your community.
- You must be present from the beginning of the OFAKIDS Scholarship Ceremony to the end (NO EXCEPTIONS).
 Please don't ask if you can be exempt from the ceremony due to work or family matters, no excuses will be accepted. You CAN NOT request for a family member to attend the ceremony to receive your check on your behalf.
- If you are unable to attend the Scholarship Award Ceremony which typically is held in August, please let us know via email prior to the event. We will allow you to attend the next Scholarship Ceremony, which will be in December of the same year.
- All the applications with all the requirements must be submitted before the due date, June 30th. Please don't
 wait until the last minute to deliver your application. If you know Mari's home address, DO NOT deliver
 applications there, it won't be accepted.
- All the requirements must be legible for consideration, incomplete applications will not be considered for the OFA scholarship. If you have any questions, please send an email to mmorales@ofakids.org.

Please print the application with all the 5 requirements which are the signed application, essay, transcript, letter of recommendation, and letter of acceptance from College/University. You may stop by the office to use our computers to complete and print your scholarship application, please email in advance to set up an appointment.

The application must be submitted by regular mail or hand delivered to the office. The One For All-OFAKIDS office is located at 925 E Redondo Blvd Suite #2 Inglewood, CA. 90302. Please email mmorales@ofakids.org in advance before delivering your application in person.
